Care & Maintenance Guide

Your base is built to run maintenance-free for years. The powder coat finish isn't — it needs the right cleaning products around it. This sheet covers what's safe, what isn't, and why it matters.





The #1 cause of rust: Floor Cleaners

Most rust we see on bases didn't come from weather — it came from industrial floor cleaners, degreasers, or disinfectants used on the surrounding floor. Splash, overspray, or standing runoff attacks the coating and lets the metal underneath start to corrode. Keep these products off the base entirely, and rinse promptly if contact happens.

DO

- ✓ Clean weekly with mild, pH-neutral soap (pH 5–8) and warm water
- ✓ Use a soft cloth or non-abrasive sponge
- ✓ Rinse with clean water and dry after cleaning
- ✓ Use isopropyl alcohol on a cloth for tree sap, ink, or adhesive spots
- ✓ Clean more often near coastlines, kitchens, and patios
- ✓ Test any new product on a hidden area first

DON'T

- ✗ Industrial floor cleaners, degreasers, or disinfectants
- ✗ Bleach or ammonia-based cleaners
- ✗ Acetone, MEK, or other ketone solvents
- ✗ Steel wool, scouring pads, or abrasive powders
- ✗ Pressure washers above 500 PSI
- ✗ Cleaners left on the surface more than an hour

Already seeing rust or discoloration?

Stop using whatever cleaner is near the base immediately. Wipe the area with mild soap and water and dry it fully. Then contact us — depending on the cause, we can send a touch-up kit or evaluate it under warranty.

What warranty covers

Your warranty covers manufacturing defects in the base and finish. It does not cover coating damage caused by cleaning products not listed above — this is the most common avoidable claim we see, and it's fully preventable by keeping harsh floor chemicals away from the base.
